

How do you know if a website is run by a genuine anti-NWO warrior or by a 'controlled opposition' agent? Here are some tell-tale signs. It is probably a shill site if:-

- 1] It is run by someone anonymous or where there is little or no information about the site's author.
- 2] The site's author does not publish his/her own personal experience of Establishment corruption.
- 3] It publishes or promotes a story which is 'far-out', lacks evidence and is repeated in similar style on known shill sites.
- 4] It publishes articles from writers who are known shills.
- 5] It publishes 'safe' material, i.e. 'news' stories or information that you'd find in your local rag. You will never find anything that is 'out of the masonic matrix'; there will be no mention of the fact Freemasonry is the evil force which keeps us all imprisoned.
- 6] It doesn't publicise anything that will help stop the NWO. For example it doesn't expose the NWO fake 'victims' or other gatekeepers [except perhaps for some famous names who are already widely exposed as being 'controlled opposition'.] Any lower profile cointelpro agents it does 'expose' is done in a half-hearted unconvincing way.
- 7] There are links to known shill sites.
- 8] Public comments are mainly from people who hide behind a pseudonym or who comment regularly on known shill sites.
- 9] Only 'approved' comments are allowed. Any kind of criticism or 'difficult' questioning is off-limits in the comments section.
- 10] When you click on it your computer security detects a malware threat.
- 11] It supports the Hollie Greig or the Nigel Cooper story.
