"The issues addressed in this investigation were whether the police shooting of Tamerlan Tsarnaev (and likely Dzhokhar Tsarnaev [how can she say 'likely'? Who is she suggesting shot Jahar if not the police??]) on Laurel Street and the shooting of Officer Richard Donohue near the corner of Laurel Street and Dexter Avenue amounted to criminal conduct [of course it was criminal; but since Marian Ryan is a member of the cover up club, that fact will not be confirmed in this 'report' [Masonic pile of poo]. Course there are much bigger criminals [and a colossal amount of them] operating in the background than the corrupt and cowardly police officers referred to here] or whether, in the totality of the circumstances, the officers who discharged their weapons were justified in their use of deadly force in the proper exercise of self-defense and/or defense of another.

The District Attorney's Office, by statute, has the duty and authority to direct and control all death investigations [the DA's Office is controlled by freemasonry and will 'investigate' all deaths as they see fit] within Middlesex County. As such, the primary goal of the investigation was to determine if any person or persons bears/bear criminal responsibility in connection with the death of Tamerlan Tsarnaev. The goal was to produce a report which would convince anyone who could be arsed reading it that there had been an investigation into whether or not any police officer could be held criminally responsible for TT's murder.

Additionally, the District Attorney's Office investigated the circumstances surrounding the injury to MBTA Officer Richard Donohue [no it didn't; that is an outright lie; it already knew who shot Dic] and the possible, even likely,??? injury to Dzhokhar Tsarnaev on Laurel Street in Watertown. The Middlesex District Attorney's Office's Chief of Homicide who doesn't have a name but who will be a very high level mason who could be relied on to conduct an appropriate Masonic 'investigation' was assigned to direct the investigation. This statement summarizes the results of the investigation. It summarizes the 'findings' of the piss take

brigade. After applying the appropriate legal standards [all legal matters are controlled by the funny handshake brigade] related to the use of deadly force in self-defense and/or defense of another, the criminal investigation into this matter is now closed without prosecution. No surprises there. Of course there could never be any prosecution since what is being played out is a *charade*, not what actually happened [to the Tsarnaev brothers that is].

And how much money did that pretend investigation cost the American public? As if you'll ever know the truth about that either.

All police officers who reported that they had fired their weapons were interviewed and those interviews were audio recorded. Name those police officers and publish those recordings. Ha ha; as if. No such recordings exist. Three of those officers Who? Name them accompanied State Police investigators assigned to the Middlesex Detectives Unit to the location of Laurel and Dexter Avenue and identified their positions when they fired their weapons. Those three interviews were video-recorded. Prove it. Publish those recordings. One of those three officers, MBTA Officer Lucas Kitto, was instrumental in identifying his partner Officer Richard Donohue's locations, activities and movements leading up to his being shot on the morning of April 19, 2013. Kitto is one of many who was spared the risk of perjuring himself during Jahar's kangaroo trial. I should just add that I am saying this based on the almost certainty that he *didn't* attend court. If I am mistaken about that please produce the transcript of his testimony, as I have searched online for one to no avail. I'll just add that it is very easy to find court transcripts of those witnesses who did give evidence in court, simply by putting the name and 'court transcript Boston Bombing' or 'court transcript Tsarnaev trial' into the search bar. In any case it is very questionable that none of the five officers – Reynolds, Maclellan, Pugliese, Colon or Menton even mention Kitto. It is also very odd that he hasn't been interviewed by the media. How come this hero isn't proud to tell his story? The only publicity he has [and the same can be said of numerous others considered to be 'Boston heroes'] is re his bravery award. "BOSTON (CBS) — As they stood side-by-side to accept the "medal of honor" Wednesday afternoon, wounded MBTA Transit Officer Dic Donohue still didn't remember anything about that night [how very convenient] and his former partner tries not to think about it." He doesn't want to think about it cos he knows he doesn't deserve a medal; he

Additionally, Boston Police officers who were present on scene during the incident but who did not fire their weapons were also **interviewed and recorded** [name them all and publicise the recordings; including Kitto's] by the Boston Police and those audio recordings were provided to the Middlesex investigators who are answerable to the same people who are behind this pseudo report and were also reviewed.

Factual Summary Factual summary, my arse. This is a regurgitation of the Masonic **script**.

On Laurel Street in Watertown, a residential area, a gun fight ensued between the occupants of the Mercedes SUV and the Honda Civic and uniformed **officers from the Watertown Police, the Cambridge Police, the State Police, the MBTA Police, the Boston University Police and the Boston Police**. So Marian Ryan, tell us, was an **army** of police officers engaged in a gun fight with these kids; or was it just a *handful* of officers?

Uniformed Watertown Police Sergeant Jeffrey Pugliese arrived at that area within **one minute of the original call**. That is not consistent with officer Reynolds' account. He testified that there had been a gunfight for **eight to nine** minutes between himself, Maclellan and the Tsarnaevs, and that this was on top of the previous gun battle that had been going on between himself and Tamerlan *before* Pug showed up.

Meanwhile, after striking the police cruiser, the Mercedes SUV operated by Dzhokhar Tsarnaev continued westbound on Laurel Street through the intersection of Dexter Avenue and Laurel Street. **There were police officers on all sides of the intersection of Laurel and Dexter and positioned around all sides of the SUV**, firing in the direction of the vehicle and its driver. So if the SUV was surrounded by armed police officers, how in the hell did Jahar get away??? Please explain Marian Ryan. **It was at this time** [where is the **evidence** for that???) that Officer Richard Donohue of the MBTA Police was **struck with a bullet** and

suffered grievous bodily injury. We don't know who shot Dic, when he was shot, where he was shot, or why he was shot. We'll probably never know. Dic will never reveal the truth; he's far too scared of the men who did it. One thing is sure, there is no evidence he was hit by 'friendly fire'. It looks like attempted murder. It is curious that he was close friends with Sean Collier, who was murdered in cold blood – by the very people who shot him and who framed the Tsarnaev brothers. We'll never know why Collier was murdered either.

The Shooting of Officer Donohue

Officer Donohue **does not have a memory** of the events on Laurel Street. **Read my BB PSY-OP pdf for more on Dic's memory.**

As a result, the information provided by **Officer Lucas Kitto**, his partner that evening, **was the primary source** used to reconstruct **Officer Donohue's movements and actions** leading up to the shooting. **So why was Lucas Kitto not required to show his face in court and be cross-examined???**

As the car was coming up Laurel, Kitto saw what appeared to be muzzle flashes coming from the driver's side toward them prior to the intersection with Dexter. **He thought the muzzle flashes were coming from the car because the muzzle flashes were moving at the same speed as the car.** **But there was no gun fire from the car because Jahar was unarmed, so where were these muzzle flashes coming from???** Well it would have to have been from a police car; so do explain that **Marian Ryan – tell us the names of the gun happy police officers who were in hot pursuit of the terrorist teen.** As the SUV continued down Laurel Street, Kitto had a **clear shot at the driver's door and he fired three times.** He **was conscious that there were officers on the other side of the street potentially in the line of fire and only fired when he had a clear shot of the driver's door.** **So Kitto had a clear shot of the door, he fired three times, and yet he was unable to disable the Merc. Huh?** **As the car drove through the intersection, Kitto saw Donohue go down to the ground to his left** and he initially thought Donohue was diving for cover. Meanwhile, the SUV crossed Dexter and took off down Laurel Street. Once the SUV passed through the intersection and was in front of 33 Laurel, there was no more firing. Officer Kitto saw Officer Donohue stand up, take one step, say he was shot and then go down and start crawling away. Kitto turned Donohue over on his back and saw a large pool of blood form. **Kitto put his hand on the wound** [Timmy Menton wants to take the credit for that. He's telling everyone that he "did

almost like a CPR move and pushed my hands into the wound” <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pufgL31ZSsg> and another officer came over to assist. **Who? Kitto took off Officer Donohue’s uniform and gear. All of it ... or just his pants? How did he remove the clothing - did he use a pair of scissors, a knife? Or did he unbutton/unzip Dic’s kegs?** He could see that there was a wound on the right leg up toward the hip. The last thing Officer Donohue said was, “Oh my God, I’ve been shot.” Kitto could see Donohue “going downhill fast.” He stopped breathing and Kitto couldn’t get a pulse. **With the assistance of other officers, CPR was initiated. Why can’t you name these officers Mrs Marian Ryan?** As soon as people became aware that Donohue had been shot, the report of “officer down” went out over the radio. **A trooper with a medical bag (Dumont) arrived** and the bag valve mask was put on Donohue. **Er didn’t Joseph Reynolds claim the credit for that?**

It was not until approximately **twenty hours** after the events on **Laurel Street and Dexter Avenue** that **Dzhokhar Tsarnaev** was arrested in a boat in the yard of a house on Franklin Street.

In April of 2015, Dzhokhar Tsarnaev was convicted in federal district court in Boston of offenses related to the Boston Marathon bombing, the shooting of Officer Sean Collier, the carjacking of Dun Meng and the commission of offenses in Watertown which resulted in injury to Officer Richard Donohue. Dzhokhar Tsarnaev is presently under indictment in Middlesex County for the following offenses: murder of MIT Police Officer Sean Collier, attempted armed robbery of Officer Sean Collier, kidnapping of Dun Meng, armed robbery of Dun Meng, four counts of armed assault with intent to murder Watertown Police Officer Joseph Reynolds, Sergeant John MacLellan, Sergeant Jeffrey Pugliese, and Officer Miguel Colon, four counts of assault and battery by means of a dangerous weapon on those same four Watertown officers, possession of a firearm, possession of a firearm with defaced serial number during the commission of a felony, and possession of a large capacity feeding device. **You can sense the smug satisfaction of the utterly corrupt Marian Ryan and her evil cohorts when they constructed that paragraph! [This ‘report’ was not compiled by just Ryan; it would have been written by a number of evil lying nameless faceless murderous bastards.]**

Incidentally why wasn’t Jahar charged with armed assault with intent to murder, assault and battery on the unnamed chaps from the Cambridge Police, the State Police, the MBTA Police, the Boston University Police and the Boston Police? Why didn’t Marian Ryan question that?

Of the two hundred and fifty-one (251) cartridge cases recovered at that Watertown location **fifty-six (56) of them were fired by the firearm used by the Tsarnaevs**, which Massachusetts State Police Lieutenant David Cahill **opined**, in his testimony in the trial of United States v. Dzhokhar Tsarnaev, **was the firearm used to kill Officer Sean Collier** at MIT on the evening of April 18, 2013. **Cahill's testimony is here** http://thebostonmarathonbombings.weebly.com/uploads/2/4/2/6/24264849/1566_day_38_march_24_2015.pdf Scroll down to p 85. You will see that actually there were 266 recovered casings. 56 of those were 9 mm. On analysis of those 56 casings Cahill made the "determination they were **all fired by the same unknown weapon**." Cahill states that after he'd "test-fired the 9 mm, I compared the test from the 9 mm to the 56 cartridges recovered from the scene, and it was **my opinion** the 56 live -- the 56 discharged cartridge casings were **fired by the 9 mm Ruger Model P95 semiautomatic pistol**." This was after he had been asked if he had attempted to determine "whether or not those 56 casings were related to **Exhibit 928**, the 9 mm you recovered on the scene." **Actually there is no exhibit 928, it is Exh 930.jpg** <https://www.justice.gov/usao-ma/tsarnaev-exhibits-day-8>

All we have is the *opinion* of an 'expert witness' who happens to be yet another Masonic suck up. That is obvious by the fact he plays along with the charade, thus doing his bit to convict Jahar.

Now scroll down to p 104 whereby Watkins asks him: "Is that the Mercedes SUV that you collected spent projectiles from? And from inside of the Mercedes -- or **embedded in the Mercedes itself were 32 spent projectiles. Is that correct?**" Cahill confirms that to be the case. When then asked if he was "able to match these to law enforcement weapons" he says "No, I was not." So if those spent projectiles that were found in the Mercedes were *not* from the police weapons, then that means the *Tsarnaev brothers* were firing at the Merc! Cahill seems to have cocked up.

Course even if that gun was the one used to kill Collier, it has **not been proven that either of the Tsarnaev brothers fired it**. I cover the Collier murder in detail in my 'BB PSY-OP' pdf.

It's not difficult to see how it was that David Cahill climbed to the lofty level of lieutenant.

Of the **nineteen police officers who self-identified as having fired on Laurel Street** through the intersection of Laurel and Dexter Avenue down to School Street, seven were Watertown Police officers, two were State

Police troopers, two were Cambridge Police officers, one was a Boston University Police officer, one was an MBTA Police officer and six were Boston Police officers. **Why doesn't she name these police officers???**

As a result of the firefight on Laurel Street through and past the intersection of Dexter Avenue, there were **up to** three people shot: Tamerlan Tsarnaev, MBTA Police Officer Richard Donohue, and **possibly Dzhokar Tsarnaev**. **Why possibly? Jahar was shot; that is a fact.**

A total **of sixty-five (65) holes/damage** to the Mercedes were noted. Most, if not all, tested positive for the presence of either lead or copper residues; **all appeared consistent in size and shape with defects caused by a gun shot**. **That's a lot of gun shots to the Merc, and yet not one of those bullets was able to pierce a tyre and thus disable the Merc.**

Notice that the witch and her cronies *repeat* their statement that David Cahill opined that the Tsarnaevs' Ruger was the weapon that killed Officer Collier, and that he **testified to this at the trial** of US v Dzhokar Tsarnaev. I don't see her and her gang commenting on Kitto's failure to testify at the trial, or on the failure of other [alleged] hero cops - which I'll come to shortly - to undergo cross examination in court!

No spent projectiles associated with injuries to Dzhokar Tsarnaev and MBTA Officer Richard Donohue have been recovered. **That's because in the case of Donohue the bullet is still lodged in his leg – so we're told; although since we haven't seen his medical records that could be a load of made up bollox too. As for Jahar, isn't it very convenient that no spent projectiles associated with his gun shot injuries were recovered ...**

There were **two gunshot wounds of the torso** of Tamerlan and both bullets were recovered. The gunshot wounds of the extremities consisted of **three gunshot wounds to the right thigh, one gunshot wound to left upper arm, one to the left forearm, one to the right upper arm, and one to the right big toe**. **Those evil murderers really made sure Tamerlan was never going to recover from his injuries, didn't they.**

The Beth Israel Deaconess records described Dzhokar Tsarnaev's injuries. Among those injuries were a **penetrating injury to the left face/jaw; multiple facial bone fractures; a complex temporal bone fracture; a superficial anterior neck wound; a shattered right scapula; a penetrating wound to the left wrist; penetrating injuries of the right thigh and the right lower extremity; and an open wound of the lower left**

extremity. The same evil murderers were attempting to murder Jahar too. Given the description of the "skip shots" fired by Sergeant Pugliese, [L.O.F.L] the damage to the carjacked Mercedes (much of it attributable to gunshots fired at it as Dzhokhar Tsarnaev drove away when making his escape from the scene), one of the Boston Police officer's description of Tsarnaev wincing as the officer fired toward the car, [name that officer, and publish the evidence given by said officer for this 'investigation'. Did this officer testify in court?] spent projectiles recovered from the SUV, and the presence of some blood on the driver's inner door, it is entirely possible that some of his injuries may have occurred on Laurel Street. However, because it cannot be determined what injuries, if any, are attributable to his capture on Franklin Street, [well since the so-called stand-off was filmed by the State Police Air Wing No. 3 helicopter, it would have been very evident if Jahar had been injured whilst hiding in the boat on Franklin Street; so he must have received all of his injuries on Laurel Street. The D A however is saying that some of his injuries may have occurred on Laurel. Talk about being vague! That being the case I think Marian Ryan needs to answer the question: WHERE THE FUCK WAS JAHAR INJURED? She also needs to tell us when Jahar was injured and by whom] and because no ballistics evidence related to any of his injuries was submitted for examination by the Massachusetts State Police, any injuries he may [so are you saying he wasn't injured??] have sustained cannot definitively be attributed to weapons fired by law enforcement [so he shot himself did he??] at Laurel Street and Dexter Avenue. Jahar was shot by unidentified Illuminati agents [very high level masons]. Carry on serving your Masonic paymasters Marian Ryan. Satan loves you. Rot in hell you evil lying witch.

At the time Officer Donohue was shot, law enforcement officers were firing at the Mercedes from at least three, if not all four, sides, as Dzhokhar Tsarnaev operated the Mercedes. Marian Ryan, tell us the names of all these officers.

The investigation could not identify conclusively which police officer or officers fired the shots that struck Tamerlan Tsarnaev, although the ballistics evidence has limited the universe of officers who could have done so to the fourteen officers, [name them] from the Watertown police, the Boston police and the Boston University police who all used Glock .40 caliber firearms. Witness interviews [publish them] as well as the evidence of a blood trail leading from the area of the driveway of 55/57 Laurel, where Sergeant Pugliese fired numerous rounds at Tamerlan Tsarnaev from the side yard of 53 Laurel Street, a distance of four to five

feet away, to the area where Sergeant Pugliese tackled him to the ground [laugh out fucking loud] in an effort to arrest him, as well as Sergeant Pugliese's description of firing low to the ground, targeting the suspect's lower extremities, and the corresponding injuries to Tamerlan Tsarnaev noted at autopsy, all point to Sergeant Pugliese as the person who most likely fired those rounds. Lying bitch Marian Ryan. Tamerlan was murdered by the same unidentified Illuminati agents as his brother. Pug is a Masonic puppet - a lying piece of shit. Read my 'BB PSY-OP' pdf for the proof of that. In any event, because Sergeant Pugliese was acting in self-defense and defense of others, i.e. police officers and civilians, when he fired shots at Tamerlan Tsarnaev, it is our determination that his conduct was not criminal. Well they can't prosecute Pug cos none of this happened in the way it's portrayed. Any attempt at a prosecution of anyone would just open one huge can of worms. That's not to say Pug or any of the other clown cops didn't have a hand in Tamerlan's murder. They might have done. More on that also in my 'BB PSY-OP' pdf.

The sham investigation could not determine conclusively that Dzhokhar Tsarnaev was shot on Laurel Street [because the people who shot him are part of the same gang who are behind this 'investigation'. Only they know where Jahar was actually shot] in the early morning of April 19, 2013, due to the absence of ballistics evidence associated with his injuries, particularly given the shooting events on Franklin Street leading up to his arrest hiding in the boat. More on that part of the charade in my pdf on the BB PSY-OP. However, there are indications that some of the injuries he sustained (which were documented in the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center records) could have occurred as he fled the area of Laurel Street in the carjacked Mercedes, based on witness statements, [publish the witness statements] the condition of the Mercedes, the presence of some small blood stains on the interior of the driver's door, and the number of bullets which penetrated the interior of the Mercedes. The officers who fired their weapons at Tamerlan and Dzhokhar Tsarnaev, after the Tsarnaevs initiated the use of deadly force in the form of gunshots being fired at the first Watertown police on scene, (as well as those officers who arrived to assist them in defending against them), and explosives being hurled at the officers, [no evidence of that, but there is plenty evidence that officers lied under oath and are therefore guilty of perjury] had a reasonable belief that they were in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury and that no other means other than the use of deadly force in the discharge of their department issued firearms would suffice - to protect and save their lives, the lives of their fellow officers and the lives of the residents of that

thickly settled residential neighborhood. Accordingly, it is our determination that his conduct was not criminal.

The investigation could not identify which gun fired the bullet which struck MBTA Officer Richard Donohue, given that the bullet still remains in his leg. However, based on (1) **witness accounts [publish them]** of where Officer Donohue was located when he was shot, (2) **witness accounts [publish them]** of **where other officers were positioned, at all four sides** of the vehicle, **[oh so you are sure that it was all four sides [not at least three ...] How many officers were there firing at the fleeing Merc? Name them all]** when they fired at Dzhokhar Tsarnaev as he drove the carjacked Mercedes down Laurel Street through the intersection of Dexter Avenue, (3) the fact that the Tsarnaev firearm, used by them during the firefight which preceded Officer Donohue's shooting, had already been discarded on Laurel Street in the vicinity of 55/57 Laurel Street and could not have been the weapon that fired that shot, (4) the absence of any evidence that Dzhokhar Tsarnaev had a firearm aimed to his left when he crossed the intersection of Laurel Street and Dexter Avenue, **which was the precise time when Officer Donohue was shot**, it seems highly likely that the shot which struck Officer Donohue was not fired by Tsarnaev, and more likely that **Donohue was injured by one of the shots fired by the law enforcement officers [so why didn't all those officers testify in court??? I've covered the testimonies of Reynolds, Maclellan, Pugliese and Colon in my pdf – THE BB PSY-OP. None of them fired at the fleeing Merc]** who were firing in self-defense and defense of others.

Given the limited number of sworn officers on duty and available to respond at that hour in Watertown and the magnitude of the threat presented by the gunfire and detonation of explosives, a request for mutual aid was made by the Watertown Police Department to other departments and radio transmissions were broadcast seeking aid, **which resulted in the quick response ???** of additional law enforcement personnel from other departments in addition to response by **uniformed off-duty** Watertown police personnel. Those officers responded to the area, **putting themselves in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury**, in order to defend both the Watertown officers, who were in the thick of the situation from the outset, and the residents of that neighborhood. **HOW MANY OFFICERS RESPONDED MARIAN RYAN??? NAME THEM ALL. PUBLISH THEIR STATEMENTS, AND THE RECORDINGS OF THEIR INTERVIEWS.**

The officers were justified in their use of deadly force to stop Dzhokhar Tsarnaev, who had, by his actions, demonstrated an utter disregard for the lives and safety of the police and residents. That is what terrorists do. That is why they're called terrorists. However it has not been proven that Jahar [or his brother] committed any acts of terrorism. There is on the other hand evidence that Marian Ryan and whoever helped her write this report is covering up for terrorists. In fact, the conduct of the Tsarnaevs starting with the alleged murder of Officer Sean Collier, the armed carjacking of Dun Meng, through and including the assault on police with gunfire and explosives indicates their escalating desperation and escalating threat to the community if not stopped. The problem is there is no evidence to link either Tsarnaev with the murder of Sean Collier, and there is no evidence that Dun Meng was carjacked, or that there was an assault on police with gunfire and/or explosions, let alone that either Tsarnaev was guilty of such crimes.

Every officer who responded to that situation did so recognizing that they were putting themselves in harm's way, placing themselves in danger of death or serious bodily injury to come to the aid and defense of their fellow officers and the citizens they are sworn to serve and protect. Marian Ryan, you can't even tell us how many of these heroes there are; let alone the names of them. Shame on you madam; promoting this story. These officers responded to this encounter in a courageous fashion which was testament to their commitment and training. Please show us the evidence. It is notable that the officers engaged the Tsarnaev brothers in such a manner that they minimized the potential for injury to any of the residents of Laurel Street and the surrounding area and no residents were injured. The masons will tell you any old crap.

There is similarly insufficient evidence available to determine which officer, if any, injured Dzhokhar Tsarnaev. So do please explain how the fuck Jahar got his injuries!!! Nevertheless, to the extent that he was injured on Laurel Street, that conduct was not criminal. It has not been proven where Jahar was injured. As for the shooting of Jahar; yes it was fucking criminal. God will one day reveal who the bastard is [or more likely who the bastards are] who did it [and who is/are now protected by the Masonic hierarchy.]

After applying the appropriate legal standards [which are all controlled by freemasonry] related to the use of deadly force in self defense and/or defense of another, the criminal investigation into this matter is closed without prosecution. The matter is being referred back to the police departments [which are all controlled by freemasonry i.e. the same piss

taking bastards who wrote this report] of the officers who fired their firearms on Laurel Street on April 19, 2013, for whatever further action, if any, they deem appropriate.”

These ‘heroes’ don’t do interviews, they just get mainstream publicity for their heroism, and recognition from the likes of Jimmy **Shillama** [more on him in my ‘JIMMYSLLAMA’ pdf

“The Law Enforcement Medal of Valor Presented to Trooper **Christopher Dumont** Danvers Massachusetts State Police. The Distinguished Medal of Valor is presented to individuals by their peers for an act of bravery or perilous risk to his or her life while performing their duty in such a manner as to reflect courage and dedication as a professional Law Enforcement Officer.”

NAUSEATING.

The following is part of a statement [published by cointelpro agent **Jimmysllama**] which was supposedly written by officer Chris Dumont. In reality it is a *masonic contrived* load of pigshit. Dumont agrees to put his name to it, and **his reward is a distinguished Medal of Valor**. I quote: “I and the no named officers around me **suspected** [based on what?] that **gunfire and additional bombs were coming from the vehicle** [what’s the point saying this? **Suspicion counts for nowt**. The reason the **masons** slipped it in is to muddy the waters, so that the public believe that Jahar was armed to the teeth as he raced off and thus still a threat [not that he actually did escape of course, and nor was he ever a threat]] **as it fled**. At that time, other officers **and I became involved in the shooting**. No evidence of that of course. And notice the vagueness. The SUV then sped north on Laurel St. past my location with **no one in pursuit**. So, according to Dumont, **no-one followed the fleeing Merc**. As the SUV went north on Laurel St., I directed a cruiser, occupied by Boston Police Gang Unit Off. **Scott Pulchansing** and Off. **Sean McCarthy**, [more new names not mentioned by anyone in court ...] to pursue it. **Seeing that none of the officers around me were injured, I then ran towards my cruiser with the intention of joining the pursuit** of the SUV. There is no evidence that any of this is true. It is all hearsay from an unknown person or unknown people [as there is no evidence that this statement even came from Chris Dumont. It isn’t even signed.]

I then attempted to have a marked cruiser moved to the driveway so that I could transport Off. Donohue rapidly to Mt. Auburn Hospital. This proved to be difficult due to a second suspect still remaining on scene and possibly posing a threat. Virtually dead Tamerlan was in handcuffs by now [so the story goes.] I remember a concern among the officers that a suspect could emerge from the yard we were in. The masons just keep coming out with any old bullshit. I then moved my unmarked cruiser to the driveway and removed my trauma medical bag in order to assist Off. Donohue. So did he tell Reynolds - who was busy performing rescue breaths after he too had grabbed his medic bag and valve mask and oxygen mask - to get the fuck away from Dic? My trauma bag, contains items not normally carried in a State Police cruiser. This includes oxygen and IV's, which I carry due to my training and for critical trauma cases. However, upon closer examination of Off. Donohue, I noted that his blood loss was too great and that an IV would not be beneficial. Off. Donohue was pale with his eyes open and lifeless. I then considered moving Off. Donohue to my unmarked cruiser for transport, but I learned that an ambulance was approaching the scene from Laurel St. Off. Donohue would need surgery and blood transfusions quickly if he was to survive this injury.

As the ambulance arrived, I directed the officers on the ground to carry Off. Donohue to the ambulance to save time. I entered the ambulance and helped load Off. Donohue onto the stretcher. The stretcher never left the truck, saving minutes of on scene time. Watertown Firefighter EMTs Patrick Menton and Jimmy Caruso joined me in the back of the ambulance. A paramedic ambulance (advanced life support) was two minutes away. A decision had already been made to leave without them and a decision was made that a transport to a Boston Trauma center was not possible. EMT Caruso and I located and examined the wound more closely. Active bleeding had stopped and it was clear that Off. Donohue had lost most of his blood. While EMT Caruso held pressure on the wound, EMT Menton and I performed CPR. With all three of us needed in the back of the ambulance to care for the officer, we shouted for an officer to drive us to Mt. Auburn Hospital. We all performed vital roles. Watertown Police Off. Tim Menton drove. Off. Donohue's partner, Off. Luke Kitto, rode as a passenger.

I estimate that the ambulance was on scene for only forty five seconds. Off. Menton, EMT Menton's brother, was familiar with the route to the hospital, which was 1.8 miles away. Off. Menton had never driven an ambulance before and he inadvertently drove the ambulance with the emergency brake on. The high speed ride to the hospital was rocky,

but took less than three minutes. The Mt. Auburn Hospital had little notice of our arrival ???”

This is seriously cringe-worthy, even for the freemasons. I think all of these so-called first responders should be forced to undergo a **televised** thorough cross examination in court. And when they are proven to be lying through their teeth they should all be prosecuted for perjury.

Dumont [or rather the Masonic fat controller] adds a list of names of “officers who assisted with CPR and bleeding control for Off.
